  - A. President-

She plans on having two riding groups and will also have ribbons for the atv’s so others know we are riding for a cause. JoAnn also stated riders can ride in memory of loved one who has lost their battle with cancer.

6. New Business
  - A. Retirement – Congratulations went out to Bill Mitchell on his retirement from the DNR.
