 - B. Member Support – Al wanted to let members know that there is a lot of work going on behind the scenes, and members need to do their part to help out. Some examples were better response to e-mails and more member involvement.
 - C. Membership – Renewals will be handed out at the December meeting.
5. Old/Unfinished Business
 - A. Stickers – Membership has asked for many years that we have a club sticker. Every membership will be getting a sticker with their renewal and we will also send out stickers to past members with a letter. New members will be getting one sticker with their membership. Remaining sticker will be sold for \$2.
 - B. Banner – Having a new banner printed has been on the agenda for some time. Tim spent about a week to get to the final design which was displayed at the meeting. The final cost (\$100) also came in under the quoted price.
 - C. Parades – several parades coming up the first is Hartford “Sound of Christmas” next weekend (Nov 14th). Anyone able to participate should let Al know. Parade etiquette will need to be followed, which includes safe and responsible riding and helmets are required. Parade details will be sent out as soon as they become available. West Bend theme is “There’s No Place Like Home for Christmas” and is the Sunday after thanksgiving (Nov. 29th). The parade committee has also asked the club to provide help during the parade and the club will provide four members w/ATVs. More information will be sent as the

information is finalized. The last parade is Kewaskum “Toys around Town” is the week following (Dec. 6th). Keep an eye on the website/email for more details.
